## I'm a School or Educator

Support Student Caregivers Through Recognition

Schools and educators are often the first to see students quietly carrying caregiving responsibilities that affect attendance, engagement, and wellbeing.

Turn Care into Credit™ (TCCSH) offers schools a simple, non-stigmatizing way to recognize these students by documenting caregiving as community service and leadership, without requiring medical disclosure or additional programming.

## What Participation Looks Like for Schools

Participation is flexible and entirely optional. Schools may choose to:

- Share TCCSH information with students and families
- Acknowledge verified caregiving as community service hours
- Provide verification through a counselor or administrator (with consent)
- Support student recognition efforts

There is no cost, no reporting burden, and no mandate to participate.

## What TCCSH Is — and Is Not

### TCCSH is:

- Voluntary
- FERPA-aware
- Youth-centered
- Respectful of school autonomy

**TCCSH is not:**

- A diagnostic or evaluation program
- A replacement for school counseling services
- A requirement imposed on schools or districts

**What Schools Receive**

- Verified service-hour documentation
- Recognition templates and letters
- Clear verification guidelines
- School-ready forms and resources
